Timing of Work

The proposed programme for completing the work listed in this annex is to be discussed between each Company and the Environment Agency Region. Dates set are generally the latest which could be acceptable: the expectation is for investigations and implementations to proceed as quickly as possible. In general the attached envisages:

- Habitats Directive sites and other SSSIs where the solution is clear, dealt with by March 2003 where possible;
- Other sites where solution is clear, dealt with to achieve a good proportion of completions by March 2003;
- Investigations to proceed as soon as possible; March 2005 is the latest date for clear conclusions.

ENVIRONMENTAL OBLIGATIONS - 2000 TO 2005

In May last year we published an open letter to the Secretary of State for the Environment, Transport and the Regions and for Wales, setting out the Agency's proposals for the environmental improvements to be implemented by the water companies during the period 2000-05. The details were set out in a plan of action in our report *A Price Worth Paying*.

The Secretaries of State considered our proposals, and the views of Ofwat on the implications for water bills, and subsequently published their guidance to the Director General of Ofwat on the environmental and quality objectives to be achieved by the water industry in England and Wales 2000-05 in their report *Raising the Quality*, September 1998.

This guidance has now been translated into detailed environmental obligations which have been agreed by the Secretaries of State for each water company. The Agency will, where appropriate, implement and enforce these obligations through changes to the water abstraction licences held by your company.

The detailed obligations for your company are attached as in Annex 1.

Annex 1 lists the requirements for the changes to the arrangements for water abstraction.

This annex constitutes the programme of environmental obligations agreed by the Secretaries of State which are to be achieved by your water company in the period 2000-05. Where possible, we have indicated provisional dates for implementing these obligations. We will be pleased to discuss these dates with you and where necessary, we will then issue a revised programme in time for any changes to be taken into account in final price limits.

I should be grateful if you would arrange for the programme of environmental obligations shown in Annex 1 to be included in your draft Business Plan which you have been asked to submit to Ofwat by 9 April 1999.
