Introduction

The North East Region extends from the Scottish Border down to the Humber Estuary encompassing the rivers Ouse and Don and their tributaries, and all tributaries flowing into the north side of the Humber.

The north of the region, notably Northumbria Area but also the rivers Tees and Esk in Dales Area, offers excellent game fishing opportunities, with salmon and sea trout being present in most rivers to a varying extent. The Coquet and Tyne are widely regarded as nationally important salmon fisheries, whilst the Yorkshire Esk is often quoted as being Yorkshire's only true salmon river. Recent water quality improvements in the River Tees mean that it is now rapidly developing as a salmon river with ever increasing rod catches.

Excellent coarse fishing opportunities exist throughout the

region, although the most northerly rivers such as the Aln and Coquet are largely devoid of such species. Further south, coarse fishing is available in the majority of rivers, particularly in the lower reaches. The recent impoundment of the lower River Tees has seen angler catches of coarse fish rise dramatically in areas where previously no fishing occurred. Water quality improvements in many of the rivers found in the Ridings Area have also resulted in incredible improvements to the fishery, notably in the rivers Don, Dearne and Rother. As the works undertaken by the Agency continue to

improve the water quality of these rivers, the fisheries can only continue to develop.

Numerous reservoirs, lakes and ponds can be found throughout the region which cater for a wide range of fishing interests, from "put and take" trout fisheries stocked with brown and rainbow trout, to mixed coarse fishing lakes, to fisheries catering particularly for specialist anglers aiming to catch large carp or pike. In Yorkshire, canal fishing offers many opportunities for coarse anglers.

Throughout this guide, the terms left bank and right bank relate to an angler facing downstream with his back to the direction of flow.

This guide is intended to introduce anglers to the fishing opportunities which exist within the region and to point you in the direction of the fishing you enjoy. Fisheries included in this guide were either nominated by the fishery owners themselves, or in certain cases contacted by Agency staff to seek permission for inclusion. The entries

rely on the information provided. It is not intended to be an exhaustive list of waters available. Entries are correct to the best of our knowledge at the time of printing and the Agency cannot accept any responsibility for omissions or errors. However, a proforma is included in the back of the guide for new entries to be included in the next print run or to identify errors.

Rod Licences

Any angler aged 12 years or older who fishes in England or Wales for salmon, trout, freshwater fish or eels is required to have a current, valid Agency rod licence which is available from all Post Offices. If you fish without a licence you will be guilty of an offence and may be liable to prosecution. In addition to holding a rod licence, you also require permission from the fishery owner before you can fish. Always make sure that you are allowed to fish before you start angling.

Income generated from rod licence sales is used directly in funding the fisheries work of the Agency and supports the grants given to the authority from central government. The work of the fisheries department includes enforcement of the fisheries laws and byelaws of the region, monitoring of fish stocks, restocking work for both game and coarse species, improving fisheries habitats and carrying out fish rescues. The Agency also works through its other functions to protect fisheries habitats by regulation of abstraction

and discharges, and careful controls of other water users.

Fishing without a rod licence reduces the amount of income the Agency receives. This has a direct affect upon the amount of money that can be spent on the region's fisheries and therefore deprives the legitimate angler of the benefits the Agency brings.

Fishing Regulations ~ Byelaws

Remember that when you are fishing you must abide by local byelaws which are intended to protect the fisheries and to allow maximum enjoyment for all. You must make sure that you are familiar with local byelaws before you go fishing and that you abide by those regulations.

A leaflet produced by the Agency explains the fisheries byelaws of the North East Region, and can be obtained from the addresses given on the back of this guide.



Movements of Fish

Under current legislation, it is an offence to transfer fish or the spawn of fish into any inland water in England or Wales without having first obtained the written consent of the Agency. This legislation is aimed at protecting fish stocks from the introduction of new diseases or parasites, and to minimise the adverse impacts that introduction of a new species can have on resident populations.

To avoid the risks associated with movements of fish when angling, try to avoid transferring live fish from one water to another for use as bait if pike fishing. It is always better to use fish from the water where you intend to go angling. When you have finished your fishing day always remember to release any live fish you have retained back into the water from which they came.

If you or your angling club intends to either introduce fish or move them around your waters, please contact your local Agency office for advice.

Angling Practices and Safety

Please consider the following suggestions when fishing so that you and other waterway users may fully enjoy time spent on or near the bankside:

- **make sure you have a rod licence and permission to fish;**
- **ensure that your vehicle and fishing tackle does not obstruct footpaths, gates or access points;**
- **always take your litter, discarded tackle and bait home. This can be dangerous to wildlife and encourages rats;**
- **don't leave baited hooks unattended, either in or out of the water;**
- **have respect for wildlife;**
- **be considerate to other users who have the right to expect peace and privacy.**

Safety

Rivers and still waters can be dangerous places. Take into account the following precautions to avoid angling accidents:

- watch out for increasing water levels;
- keep an eye on the weather and the colour of the water (flood water increases the water colour);
- don't panic if you fall in, go with the current until you reach a shallow bank;
- when wading make sure the soles of your waders grip properly and carry a wading staff;
- look behind you when casting;
- in an electric storm, cease fishing, put your rod down and move away from it.

If fishing from a boat, remember:

- don't take a boat out unless you are fully experienced;
- check the safety and stability of the craft and wear a life jacket;
- unless absolutely necessary, do not fish alone, and fish seated;
- if the boat capsizes, stay with it unless you are close enough to swim to the shore safely;

- do not wear waders in boats;
- take navigation aids and distress signals;
- listen in advance to weather forecasts;
- leave a message saying where you are.

Overhead Power Wires

Fishing near overhead power lines can be extremely dangerous and has resulted in serious injury or death to anglers. Even if your rod does not come into contact with a power line, electricity can arc across and deliver a potentially lethal charge to the angler. Make sure that:

- you are aware of any nearby overhead power lines when fishing, and if possible avoid fishing close to them;
- your rod, pole or line does not touch or go anywhere near electrical wires overhead;
- particular caution is applied if your rod or pole is made of carbon fibre, as it is a strong conductor of electricity.

Blue-Green Algae

Blue-green algae are natural inhabitants of many inland waters, estuaries and the sea. In still fresh waters, such as lakes, ponds, canals and reservoirs, these algae may multiply sufficiently in summer months to discolour the water such that it appears green, blue-green or greenish brown. During calm weather the blue-green algae can rise to the

water surface to form a scum, and may form flocs. These algae are also known to produce chemicals which can be toxic to mammals, including man. These toxins have caused deaths of farm animals and pet dogs in the U.K. In humans, rashes have occurred following skin contact and diseases have developed when blue green algae has been swallowed.

Further details are contained within the Agency leaflet on blue green algae.

Weil's Disease (Leptospirosis)

Weil's disease is carried by rats and can be caught by humans to whom it is potentially fatal. *Leptospira*, the organism that causes Weil's disease can be present in water or in the mud around watercourses. It can enter the body through cuts and grazes, through the mouth or via the mucus membranes such as those which line the eyes and the nose. The early stages of the disease may closely resemble influenza, with fevers, rigours and myalgia. Early diagnosis and treatment are vital.

Rivercall

A region-wide telephone service is available which allows anglers to gain information on the levels of a number of rivers. The information on this system is updated daily from the Agency's remote gauging units in order to ensure that it is as up to date as possible. The river level is given as height above or below normal summertime flow. The phone numbers for this service are as follows:

Calls are charged at 45p per minute cheap rate and 50p per minute at all other times. Calls last approximately two minutes. The revenue generated by Rivercall pays for the cost of the service. Any surplus income will go to funding

fisheries improvements within the region.

In addition to these lines, Northumbrian Water also provide a phone line to give information on releases from Kielder Reservoir at the head of the North Tyne. This phone number is 01434 240463 (charged at standard phone rates).

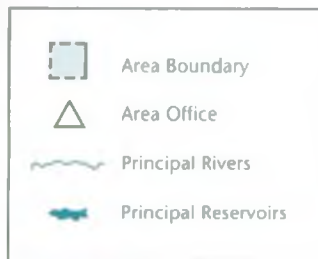

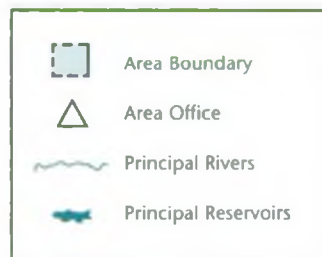

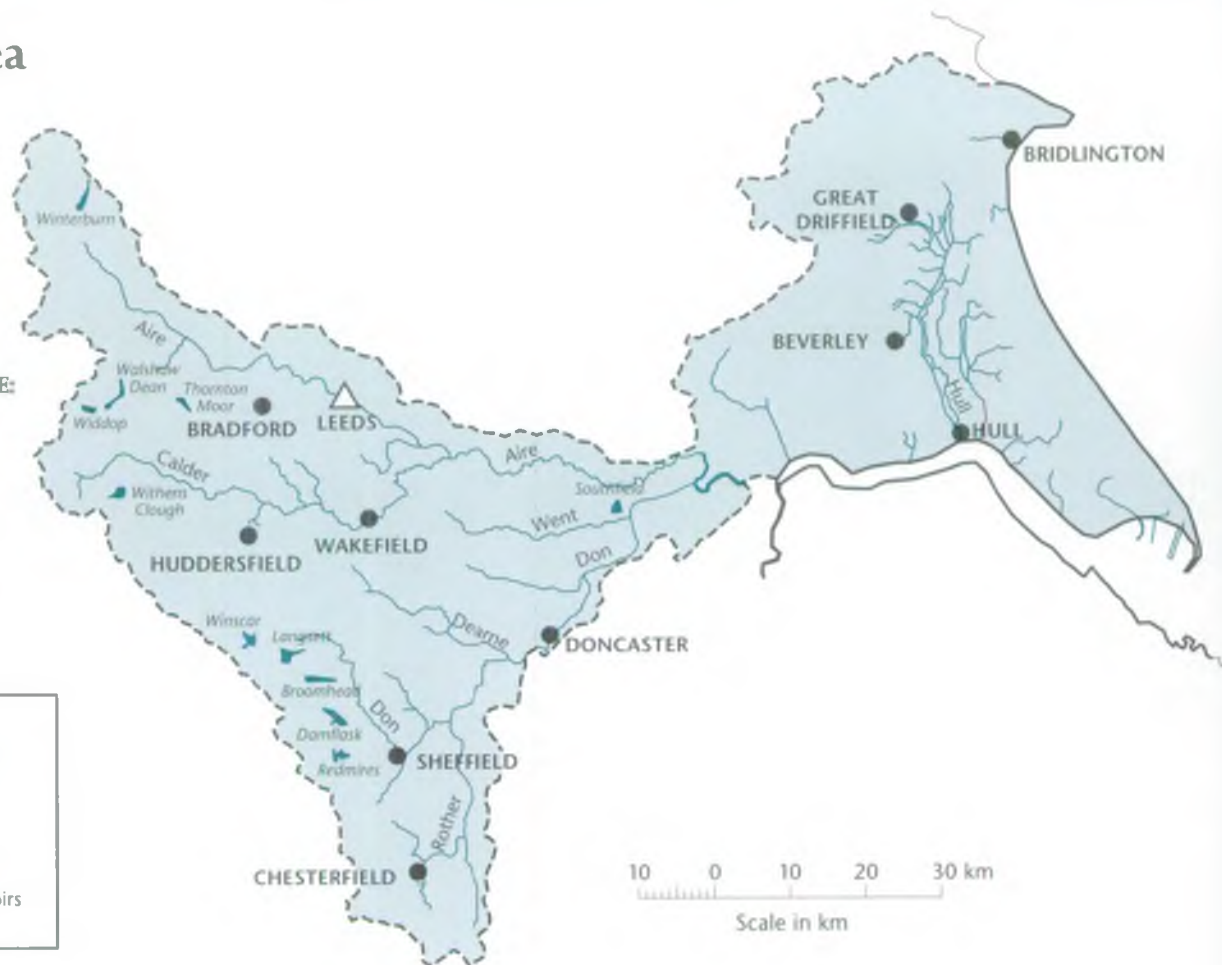

Agency Salmon Hatchery

A salmon hatchery was constructed at Kielder in Northumbria, to produce 160,000 juvenile salmon per year to stock into the North Tyne following the loss of spawning beds due to the construction of Kielder Reservoir. However the hatchery has been so successful that it is now producing up to 500,000 or more juvenile salmon to stock into the regions' rivers guided by the Agency's monitoring programmes and stocking strategies.

The hatchery is open to the public for visits every Wednesday from 1st May to 30th September at 2.00pm and 3.00pm. Tickets are priced at £1.00 (concessionary price 50p) and are available from the Tower Knowe Visitor Centre on Kielder Reservoir – telephone 01434 240398.

Tag Recovery ~ Reward

Each year the Agency tags several thousand young salmon and sea trout, both at its own salmon hatchery at Kielder and in the wild. When these fish return as adults, the tags can provide the Agency with important

information regarding their life cycles. These tags are very small (about 1mm long) and are implanted in the nose of the fish. As these are not visible, the fish are marked by removal of their adipose fin. Fish are anaesthetised during the process and are not harmed in any way. Once clipped in this manner, these fish are easily recognisable.

If you catch a fish with its adipose fin missing, you are entitled to a reward which will be paid if the fish or head of the fish is made available to the Agency for inspection. If you catch an adipose fin-clipped salmon or sea trout, please inform the Agency:

Dial 100 and ask for 'FREEPHONE FISHWATCH'

- Tell us your name, address and telephone number.
- Provide details of when and where your fish was caught.
- Give details of the species, length and weight of the fish.

In addition, the scales from your fish can provide valuable information pertaining to its life history. Please retain a few scales taken from one flank of the fish between the dorsal and tail fins.

You will be contacted as soon as possible to arrange for the fish to be inspected.

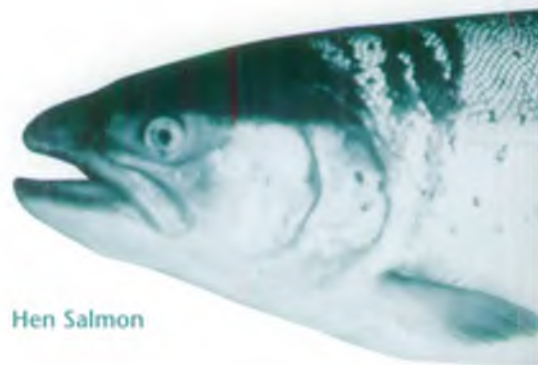
Catch and Release

Salmon stocks around the country are under increasing pressure. The Agency is therefore seeking to do everything possible to protect the species. One way in which salmon anglers can help to protect the species and ensure their sport for future years is by not retaining every fish they catch.

If adequate care is taken by the angler in the use of appropriate fishing tackle, the way in which it is played and the way it is treated when grassed, then even late running fish can be returned to the water from where they will have a good chance of successfully

continuing their migration upstream to the spawning beds.

Always make sure that your tackle is strong enough to handle the fish you are trying to catch. Try to bring the fish to the bank or boat as quickly as possible to avoid tiring and when it is on the bank, try to remove the hook and return the fish to the water as quickly and gently as possible.

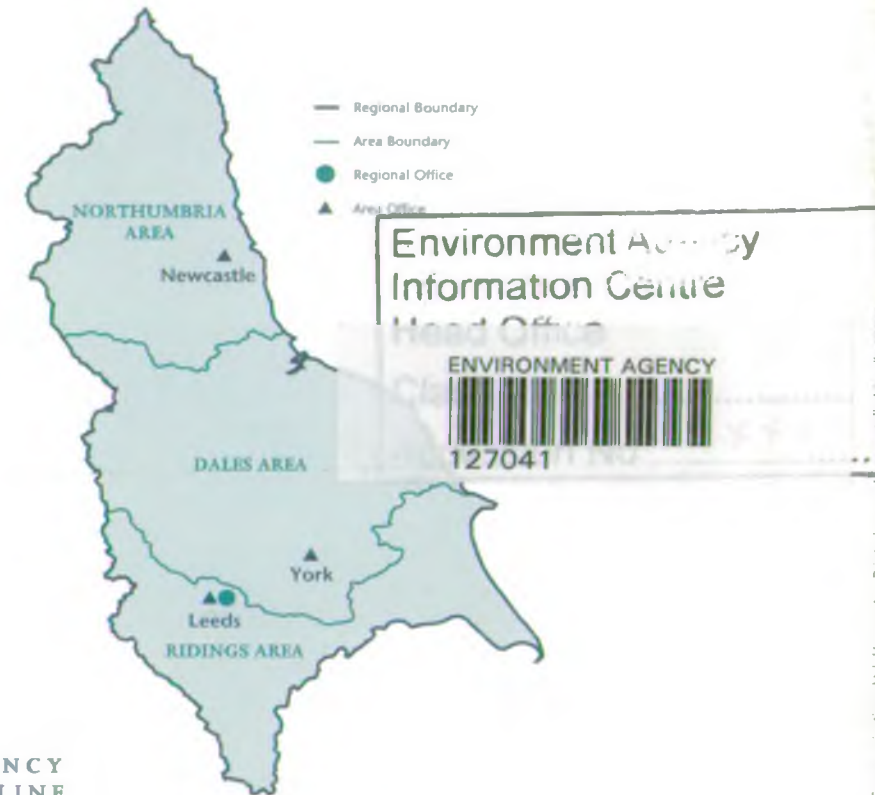
