

INTRODUCTION

This document provides a summary of the regulation, guidance and direction making powers of Ministers in the Environment Act 1995 as they relate to the Environment Agency functions (it does not cover issues relating to Scottish Environment Protection Agency, mineral planning permissions etc). The document should be read in conjunction with the document containing a summary of the duties and powers of the Environment Agency.

All references in this document to section numbers are to section numbers in the Environment Act 1995, unless specified otherwise. Relevant dates have been supplied where known.

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1. OBJECTIVES OF ENVIRONMENT AGENCY

12. EFFICIENT USE OF WATER

This para inserts a new section to the Water Industry Act 1991 imposing a duty on every water undertaker to promote the efficient use of water by its customers. THE DIRECTOR (not the Secretary of State) has power to require a water undertaker to take certain action in performance of its duty. Duty on Director to consult with the undertaker before imposing any requirement, which requirement may include making facilities and information available to customers.
