IDENTIFIED USES OF TIDAL WATERS

1. INTRODUCTION

The NRA South West region has thus far, only formally identified water quality objectives for tidal waters where areas have been identified under the particular European Commission Directives (eg. Bathing Water Directive and Shellfish Waters Directive). This report is the result of an exercise which has been carried out to identify all legitimate uses in tidal waters around the region.

The identification of uses is essential because water quality standards are assigned to each use. In any particular water the more stringent standard of the relevant uses will apply. These form the basis of targets to maintain and improve water quality.

2. REVIEW PROCESS

A project team was set up in 1990 with the following terms of reference:-

- (a) To examine the inherited uses of the Region's controlled waters.
- (b) To identify the extent of controlled waters and the current water quality monitoring programme.
- (c) To review the definitions of existing water uses and confirm water use definitions.
- (d) To propose current and potential water uses for surface freshwaters based on the current monitoring network.
- (e) To propose current and potential uses for groundwaters.
- (f) To propose current and potential uses for tidal waters.

3. REVIEW OF WATER USES

The following categories of uses have been developed:-

- (i) basic amenity
- (ii) general ecosystem
- (iii) special ecosystem
- (iv) migratory fishery
- (v) commercial harvesting of fish
- (vi) commercial harvesting of shellfish
- (vii) water contact activity
- (viii) industrial and/or agricultural use
- (ix) emergency services

The definitions of these uses were reviewed and are included in Appendix 7.1.

The review process has, thus far, only involved internal consultation to apply these reviewed uses to tidal waters.

The result of this consultation is presented in schedule and map format in two supporting volumes. Volume 1 contains maps covering Lyme Regis to Looe and Volume 2 contains maps for Fowey to Foreland Point.

4. STATUTORY WATER QUALITY OBJECTIVES

The government currently proposes to apply Statutory Water Quality Objectives (SWQO's) initially to rivers, (1). Once the Secretary of State for the Environment has agreed the final scheme, it seems likely public consultations on the proposed SWQO's will take place on a catchment by catchment process based on a regional priority system.

As part of this process it will be necessary to identify current and proposed water use.

Following the review of uses of tidal waters that has been undertaken during 1991 and 1992, catchment water quality plans will be prepared progressively from early 1993. These will identify, as far as is possible, waters needing improvement, the causes(s) of non compliance and proposed remedies.

5. INTERNAL CONSULTATION

The internal consultation is now complete and the proposed identified uses have been agreed. It is anticipated that the maps and schedules will be updated from time to time (probably on an annual basis).

APPENDIX 7.1

PROPOSED USES OF CONTROLLED WATERS

BASIC AMENITY

Maintain or improve water quality so as to prevent public nuisance arising from visual and smell problems.

GENERAL ECOSYSTEM

2A For Controlled Waters of, or near to pristine conditions, receiving no substantial direct or indirect discharges:

Promote all aquatic life and dependent non-aquatic organisms, so that the ecosystem is typical of a Controlled Water with those physical and chemical characteristics, flow regime and location.

2B For Controlled Waters receiving substantial discharges, and where achievement of pristine conditions is impracticable:

Ensure that for estuarine and coastal waters;

- it supports a variety of aquatic life and dependent nonaquatic organisms;
- ii) where appropriate fish and shellfish are protected;
- iii) where appropriate it supports a flora and fauna essential to sustain sea fisheries.

3. SPECIAL ECOSYSTEM

Safeguard the special conservation interest for which the Controlled Water is identified. The following designations (whether existing or proposed) are taken into account:

- National Parks
- Areas of Outstanding National Beauty
- Sites of Special Scientific Interest
- Environmentally Sensitive Areas
- Nature Reserves
- Areas of Special Protection for Birds (designated by the Secretary of State under the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981)
- Ramsar Sites (under conventions on wetlands of International Importance, especially as Wildfowl Habitat)
- Special Protection Areas (under EC Directive on the Conservation of Wild Birds 79/409)
- Heritage Coasts
- Ancient Monuments
- National Nature Reserves
- Marine Nature Reserves
- Local Nature Reserves
- RSPB Reserves
- Voluntary Marine Nature Reserves
- Environmentally Sensitive Areas
- Sites with Red Data Book species

4. MIGRATORY FISHERY

Maintain or improve water quality so as to protect passage of all relevant species of migratory fish where this is not prevented by natural physical barriers.

5. COMMERCIAL HARVESTING OF MARINE FISH FOR PUBLIC CONSUMPTION

Ensure that commercial marine fish quality shall be acceptable for human consumption as determined by the appropriate Competent Authorities (e.g. MAFF).

6. COMMERCIAL HARVESTING OF SHELLFISH FOR FUBLIC CONSUMPTION

Ensure that commercial shellfish quality shall be acceptable for human consumption as determined by the appropriate Competent Authorities (e.g. MAFF).

7. WATER CONTACT ACTIVITY

Maintain or improve water quality so as to protect those engaged in water contact — related activities.

8. INDUSTRIAL AND/OR AGRICULTURAL USE

Safeguard industrial abstractors, and where water is used for agricultural purposes, maintain water quality so as to protect the health and well being of affected animals, avoid damage to crops, and safeguard public health.

9. EMERGENCY SERVICES

Maintaining the area of controlled water by ensuring that the activities of the 'emergency services' do not cause unacceptable deterioration in water quality.






LYME REGIS TO CULVERHOLE POINT - GENERAL ECOSYSTEM CONSERVATION


AXE ESTUARY - ESTUARY BOUNDARY


AXE ESTUARY - GENERAL ECOSYSTEM CONSERVATION


AXE ESTUARY - SPECIAL ECOSYSTEM CONSERVATION (MAP 1)




CHIT ROCKS TO BEER - SPECIAL ECOSYSTEM CONSERVATION (MAP 1)




BUDLEIGH SALTERTON TO CHIT ROCKS SPECIAL ECOSYSTEM CONSERVATION (MAP 1)

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
OTTER ESTUARY - BATHING WATERS










HORE STONE TO PENCARROW HEAD - SPECIAL ECOSYSTEM CONSERVATION (MAP 1)






